

Dear Friends and Family,

Thank you so much for your continued prayers and monetary support for our family and ministry. We are continuing to praise our gracious God for his provision and care for us. We have seen him provide for our needs over the last few months in unexpected ways.

Beginning in September, we made some changes to our Sunday morning meeting schedule, hoping to be able to get more people involved. We now start our morning worship at 10 am. We begin with a prayer time beforehand at 9:30, where we specifically pray for the worship time coming up. At 10 am, we begin with prayer and scripture to focus our minds on God's Word, a congregational song, and then Jeremy preaches. After he is finished preaching, we have small group discussion/discipleship time.

This discussion time is designed to help people apply what they just heard. After small groups, we come back together to worship in song.

Most people have been very enthusiastic about our new schedule, and it has been wonderful to see more people get involved in our discussion time. We have already seen spiritual growth in people who formerly would just show up for the Sunday morning worship service and nothing else.

Sadly, we have lost a few people over these changes, but most people are very excited about it.

We have mentioned Jeff, who has been going through a Bible study with Jeremy. Well, he finished the first study, and now his wife has joined them for a Won by One Bible study. They started the study today, and she had a very warm reception to the Word of God. Please pray with us that she (and their daughter) would come to Christ!

Also in September, we started setting aside Sunday nights as fellowship/outreach nights. Two Sunday nights a month we meet in different homes, with the goal of inviting our neighbors and friends in the community, and the other two Sunday nights we do some kind of outreach. This has included, so far, passing out church brochures at K-Mart, and having a group picnic in the park, with the intention of meeting people. The first picnic we had a couple weeks ago was a great success!

Jeremy brought his hawk, and Eddy Alexander helped him put on a demonstration. That drew quite a crowd, and gave Jeremy and Eddy both opportunities to talk to people at length afterwards and tell them what we are all about.

Please pray for obvious fruit from the Word of God and open doors for the Gospel.
